1. Largo

- V1 2nd beat: rest notated with dotted eighth note-rest 12
- V1 4th note G has a dot. 14
- V1 3rd beat notated 15
- 17 BCTwo superimposed bass staves, upper staff erroneous, lower staff corrected.

Clean copy on the lower staff.

Vl 1st beat notated with equal eighth notes. 20

2. Allegro

- 3rd beat, ink stain covers last note, therefore the accidental is uncertain: \(\dagger or \(\beta\) 9 V1
- Suggested alternative C V1 10
- 3rd beat, last note notated \$ 15 Vl
- 18 BCLast note: B
- From 3rd beat, the end of the movement is to be found on f.4v, at the end of the Sonata in D 21 Major by Heinichen
- 2nd note: G 26 V1
- 3rd beat: C 30 V1
- V1 2nd beat: Ab 31
